First Reading: Joshua 5:9a, 10-12

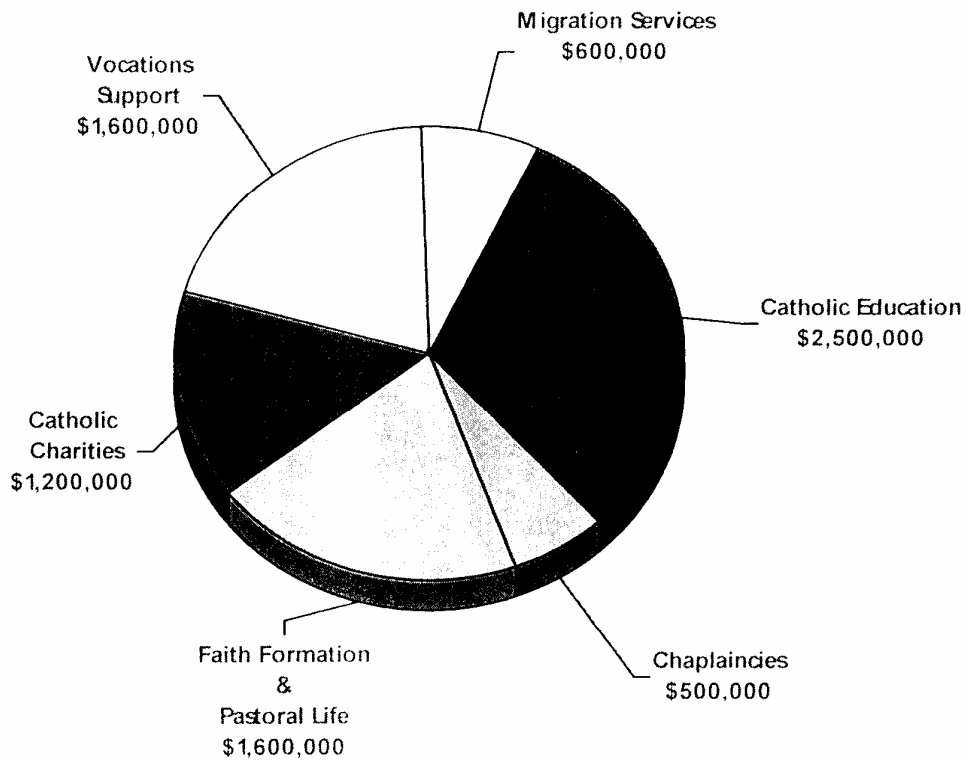
